

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE NATIONAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION  
AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE HELD ON  
22 NOVEMBER 2010 AT 5.15 P.M. CET AT THE NEC'S HEADQUARTERS**

On 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2010 at 5.15 p.m. CET at the headquarters of the National Electoral Commission, press conference about the results of elections for the president of the capital city of Warsaw, established on the basis of electronically obtained data as of 4.30 p.m. CET, was held.

Deputy Chairperson of the National Electoral Commission, Stanisław Kosmal announced partial unofficial results of the voting as of 4.30 p.m. CET established on the basis of electronically obtained data from 718 protocols approved by the Municipal Electoral Commission in Warsaw, out of the total number of 857 protocols in the voting for the president of the capital city of Warsaw, which constitutes 83.78% of all votes.

The results of the three candidates with the highest numbers of votes were presented. According to the data, Hanna Beata Gronkiewicz-Waltz from the Electoral Committee Platforma Obywatelska RP (Civic Platform of the Republic of Poland) obtained 53.34% of votes; Czesław Bielecki from the Electoral Committee Prawo i Sprawiedliwość (Law and Justice) obtained 23.33% of votes; and Wojciech Michał Olejniczak from the Electoral Committee SLD (Alliance of the Democratic Left) obtained 13.45% of votes.

Judge Stanisław Kosmal announced, moreover, that it had been the last announcement and the last press conference of the National Electoral Commission on 22<sup>nd</sup> November. It may be expected that the next press conference will take place after obtaining all data from all electoral commissions, which may be on 23<sup>rd</sup> or 24<sup>th</sup> November.

**On the basis of electronically obtained information about the results of voting from 718 protocols approved by the Municipal Electoral Commissions in Warsaw, out of the total of 857 voting protocols from the elections for the president of the capital city of Warsaw (which constitutes 83.78% of all protocols), the National Electoral Commission announces that partial unofficial results of the ballot are as follows:**
