

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE NATIONAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION  
AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE HELD ON  
6<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER 2010 AT 00:45 A.M. CET AT THE NEC'S HEADQUARTERS**

On 6<sup>th</sup> December 2010 at 00:45 a.m. CET at the headquarters of the National Electoral Commission, another press conference on the day of runoff for the positions of reeves, mayors and presidents of cities was held.

Conference participants:

Member of NEC: Andrzej Mączyński,

Member of NEC: Janusz Niemcewicz,

Secretary of NEC: Kazimierz Czaplicki – Head of the National Electoral Office.

Judge Janusz Niemcewicz announced partial unofficial results of voting as of 00:31 a.m. CET established on the basis of electronically obtained data from 8 724 protocols approved by territorial electoral commissions, out of the total number of 9 706 protocols.

In elections for the positions of reeves, mayors and presidents of cities, the turnout reached 35,30%. Out of the total number of 728 reeves, mayors and presidents of cities elected, results were established in the case of 184 communes and cities.

Judge Andrzej Mączyński presented percentage results of voting for presidents in selected cities.

Next unofficial partial results of voting may be expected after the NEC obtains 90% of protocols from electoral commissions. Press conference is planned for 2:00 a.m. on 6<sup>th</sup> December 2010.

**On the basis of electronically obtained information about the results from 8 724 protocols of precinct voting, approved by territorial electoral commissions, out of the total of 9 706 voting protocols, the National Electoral Commission announces that partial unofficial results of the ballot are as follows:**

**I.**

1) the number of people eligible to vote amounted to <b>10 712 931</b> ;
2) the number of valid ballot papers amounted to <b>3 781 468</b> ;
3) the turnout reached <b>35,30%</b> ;

4) out of the total number of **728** reeves, mayors and presidents of cities elected, results were established in **184** communes and cities.
