

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE NATIONAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION
AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE HELD ON
5th DECEMBER 2010 AT 8:30 P.M. CET AT THE NEC'S HEADQUARTERS**

On 5th December 2010 at 8:30 p.m. CET at the headquarters of the National Electoral Commission, the fourth press conference on the day of runoff for the positions of reeves, mayors and presidents of cities was held.

Conference participants:

Deputy Chairperson of NEC: Jan Kacprzak,

Member of NEC: Stanisław Zabłocki.

Deputy Chairperson of NEC, Judge Jan Kacprzak announced that on the basis of data obtained from 9 705 precinct electoral commissions until 7.00 p.m. CET, 3 899 224 ballot papers were issued, which constitutes 32.12% of the total number of eligible voters.

Judge Jan Kacprzak summarized the turnout in individual provinces. The highest turnout was registered in świętokrzyskie province (38.47%), the lowest in śląskie (26.41%).

Judge Stanisław Zabłocki summarized the turnout in selected cities. The highest turnout was registered in Sopot (50.29%), the lowest in Sosnowiec (18.94%). In comparison with the number of people eligible to vote, the highest turnout was registered in the commune of Andrzejewo, ostrowski county, in mazowieckie province – 72.90%.

Judge Jan Kacprzak informed the journalists about incidental violations of election silence. According to data obtained from the Operational Centre of the Chief Police Officer between 4:00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. CET, in total 7 cases of violation of election silence were registered countrywide. All notifications about violations of election silence are constantly verified by the police.

Judge Jan Kacprzak announced that the next press conference would take place at the NEC's headquarters around 11:00 p.m. CET.

I. Aggregate countrywide information

On the basis of data obtained from 9 705 out of 9 706 precinct electoral commissions, the National Electoral Commission announces that as of **7.00 p.m. CET** on 5th December 2010:

1. The number of voters eligible to vote in the elections, i.e. the number of voters included in the register of voters in precincts from which data was obtained, amounted to 12 139 619.
2. Ballot papers were issued to 3 899 224 eligible voters, which constitutes 32.12% of the total number of people eligible to vote in the elections.
